Call to Order		President Rod Watson opens the meeting at 5:08 pm. SW Polk Fire District has a quorum of directors and will allow deliberation, decision making, and will take public comment per the posted agenda. Pledge of Allegiance is recited.

Volunteer Handbook	Discussion	The board reviews suggested changes to the volunteer handbook. Discussion regarding leaving the Deputy Chief as the point of contact regarding certain issues for the volunteers. Hertel states the Deputy Chief has the training to deal with a variety of legal issues. Moore expresses support for keeping the Deputy Chief involved, stating it allows conversation between staff and volunteers. Watson states he's sensitive to the volunteers' concern regarding feeling left out. Discussion regarding by-laws in the volunteer handbook. Hertel states the by-Laws are a policy of the organization and cannot be changed except by the Board of Directors (BOD). Discussion of having volunteer officers as part of the volunteer review board. Hertel states the Association President is already that representative and does not recommend making a change. Hertel recommends removing the voting power of Legacy Members (members with 10 years of good standing but no longer wish to be a regular member). Rod Watson closes the workshop at 6:10 p.m. to commence the regular board meeting.		
Regional Training Center		Rod Watson reopens the workshop at 7:20 p.m. Hertel introduces an email from Brian Latta in response to the BOD's proposal of a joint training facility with Dallas Fire & EMS. He explains that staff has drafted an email in response to Latta's questions and it's up to the BOD to approve. Discussion of the benefit of cost reduction since SW Polk already has some of their facilities developed and of the viability of a training area.
